2. **90-Day Employment Assistance** – Job readiness training, resume building, interview coaching, and direct employment connections.
3. **Trade Introductions** – Exposure to vocational training programs and trade certification opportunities in various industries.
4. **Credit & Budget Counseling** – Financial literacy programs teaching savings, budgeting, and credit-building strategies.
5. **Home Ownership Introduction** – Education on property ownership, mortgage processes, and long-term financial planning.

Each program is designed to equip young mothers with sustainable skills that foster financial independence and self-reliance.

Community Impact & Reach

Ari's Room aims to serve dozens of families annually, providing them with the support needed to overcome housing insecurity and economic hardship. Our program is tailored to:

- **Decrease homelessness rates** among young mothers and children in Connecticut.
